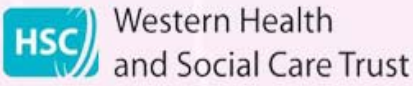

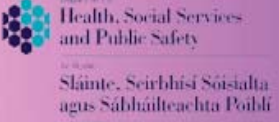

Triangle Project, 1999:

- Patients with kidney failure in border counties have multiple specific disadvantages:
- Regional specialist services are remote;
- Transport infrastructure is generally poor;
- General measures of poverty and disability are higher than average.
